

Ordinance No. 823

AN ORDINANCE of the City of Tonasket, Washington, amending the 2021 Budget Ordinance #819.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Tonasket adopted the 2021 Budget, Ordinance #819 and;

WHEREAS, it was not known at the time of the adoption of the budget the loans on the police vehicles would be paid off;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TONASKET, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. Current Expense Budget Revenues and Expenditures to be increased by \$50,000 to pay off the two police vehicle loans.

Section 2. The additional funds will come from an increase in the beginning fund balance in the Current Expense Fund; Beginning Cash and Investments 2021 Budget \$400,000. increased to \$450,000.00.
